USING RESOURCES

USING THE ORC RECORD

When the brief record appears after a search or browse, select "View Full Record" to get more information. On the full record, you'll find a complete commentary, resource type, standards alignment, and much more! Click on the URL to go to the resource.

CREATING MY ORC COLLECTION

To bookmark ORC resources in "My ORC Collection," find a resource to put into your collection. Click on "Add to My Collection" on the brief or full record. You'll be asked to log in with your email and password. If you are not registered, select "Join ORC" to set up your account. Follow the prompts on the page to create a folder and add your own commentary. Once you have an item in your collection, you can go to "My ORC Collection," located in the upper right corner, to view your collection at any time.

Share your folder from your collection with grade-level teams, departments, or other teachers. Copy and paste the folder's URL into an email.

BROWSE BY SUBJECT AREA (A PAGE FOR YOU)

Choose Mathematics Educators, Science Educators, or English Language Arts Educators from either the top of the page in the red menu bar or the left navigation bar under ORC Features.

SEARCH

SEARCH RESOURCES

Find "Search Resources" in the left navigation bar. If you know the ORC number, you can enter it into the search box under "Search Resources." You'll be taken directly to that resource.

You can enter a topic in the search box, but if you want to be more specific, click on either "Go to Search" below the search box or the double-arrow button on the right.

Now you can enter a topic and specify whether you want the search engine to search for

the phrase, the exact terms, or all the terms. You can also select the grade level(s) and the subject.

Still have too many resources to choose from? Choose "More Search Options."

You can enter more search terms and limit them. You can limit your search to a project and/or a resource type. By limiting your search, the search will be more precise, and you'll get fewer returns.

SEARCH THE ENTIRE SITE AND SITE MAP

Find It Faster @ ORC, located in the top right corner of every page, lets you search the entire site. Just enter a topic or keyword and click Go.

The site map, shown just below the site search box, provides a list of ORC features with links to each.
